U18 Premier League – MSPSP - Michigan State Premier Soccer Program.

The team plans to compete in the Michigan State Premier Soccer Program (MSPSP). A home or away game will be played typically on weekends, usually on Sundays, between the second weekend in September and the last weekend in October and will involve travel to the metro-Detroit area.

Tournament Teams

Players from NS94 & NS95, rostered or reserve, may be invited to participate in a tournament or event as part of a team assembled for that specific purpose. These events are above and beyond the events listed in the team plan and are by invitation only. Eligibility is determined by:

- 1) Member in good standing of a current NorthStar Senior team
- 2) Demonstrates effective team behaviors
- 3) Technical and tactical abilities
- 4) Positional need

These events will have their own budgets. Funds must be paid by the date set by the Coach and Business Manager in order to be on the roster. Players not paid by that date will be dropped from the roster. If a suitable alternate is available, they may be invited by the coach to fill that spot. If the minimum roster size set by the coach for the event is not met, the team will be dissolved and not registered for the event. Any player dropping out of the event after the committal date will not receive a refund of funds paid.

Homework and Special Assignments:

Players and Parents will read the book: ***Coach – Lessons on the Game of Life by Michael Lewis*** Discussions will take place at practices and any away events in which the majority of the team is housed in the same location.

Service:

An important part of a player's NorthStar experience will be participation in community service activities as a team. NorthStar will arrange special events throughout the year in coordination with Northern Michigan Special Olympics for players and parents to work closely with Special Olympic athletes learning and playing soccer. We will also volunteer in a local event (i.e. TC Triathlon, Bay Shore Marathon, Backpacks for Kids, etc)

Parental Involvement:

All parents will be encouraged and expected to volunteer for various duties that will be needed by the team and the NorthStar organization. A team business manager, treasurer, uniform coordinator, travel coordinator, fund-raising coordinator, etc. will be identified after tryouts and as team rosters are completed.
