Tryouts/Invitation/Acceptance to team

Please bring completed paperwork to tryouts. See the NorthStar tryout webpage to print out the appropriate forms. After tryouts, your invitation from the coach, and your acceptance to play on the NS97 team for the 2010-2011 soccer season, players will have until June 28 to complete the online registration process. Initial payment is due at time of online registration. Please check Player Budget information at the NS97 webpage.

Fall 2010/Spring 2011 League Play (Sep/Oct 2010 & Apr/May 2011)

The team plans to compete in the Michigan State Premier Soccer Program (MSPSP) U14 Division. A home or away game will be played typically on weekends, usually on Sundays, between the second weekend in September and the last weekend in October and will involve travel to the metro-Detroit area. Spring MSPSP league will involve travel in April and May 2011.

Tournament Teams

Players from any Senior Division team, rostered or reserve, may be invited to participate in a tournament or event as part of a team assembled for that specific purpose. These events are above and beyond the events listed in the team plan and are by invitation only. Eligibility is determined by:

- 1) Member in good standing of a current NorthStar Senior team
- 2) Demonstrates effective team behaviors
- 3) Technical and tactical abilities
- 4) Positional need

Winter Training (November 2010-February 2011)

Winter training will be comprised of 1-1.5 hour training sessions. All players are expected to participate in these Sunday afternoon sessions that run from November-February. See NS97 webpage for details.

Service:

An important part of a player's NorthStar experience will be participation in community service activities as a team. NorthStar is staffed and run by an all-volunteer team. NorthStar will ask parents to volunteer for various tasks needed by the team and the NorthStar Soccer Club. Team-specific volunteers (i.e., business manager) will be identified as team rosters are completed. The NorthStar Soccer Club will provide on-going support and guidance for these volunteers. Parents will also be asked to provide volunteer support for Club fundraisers.
