Registration for NorthStar Academy is completed on-line. Space is limited to the first 20 U10 players. There is no try-out for these teams - registration is "first-come, first-served." There is a \$100.00 payment due at time of registration.

Team Meeting/Player Registration Event

The registration day for all NorthStar teams to complete all required paperwork (paperwork-pictures-payments-medical release-birth certificates) will be on a date to be decided in early August. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT A PARENT AND THE PLAYER ATTEND THE REGISTRATION EVENT. If you cannot attend this event, **prior** notification MUST be given to the coach and the Team Business Manager. All paperwork MUST be completed by this date. A time and location will be announced soon.

Fall & Spring Practice/Training (Keystone Complex and or Bowers Harbor Park)
